About this piece

Gothic Revival brass ceiling light produced around c.1895, representing the continued influence of medieval architectural motifs within late Victorian interior design. During this period, the *Gothic Revival* (1830–1900) style evolved towards simplified ecclesiastical forms suitable for domestic and institutional lighting.

The chandelier is constructed in solid brass, comprising a circular band pierced with alternating trefoil and fleur-de-lis motifs. The upper section rises through twisted brass supports to a shaped finial with scroll details, while the lower edge terminates in a turned pendant knob.
