About this piece

A **Regency style circular convex mirror**, circa 1920, with ball and ribbon decoration around the frame. The convex plate creates a widened reflective view, while the gilt and painted surround follows the decorative vocabulary of early 19th-century English **Regency design**, revived in the early 20th century. Such mirrors were often used as focal points in dining rooms or halls, valued for both their ornamental quality and practical effect.
