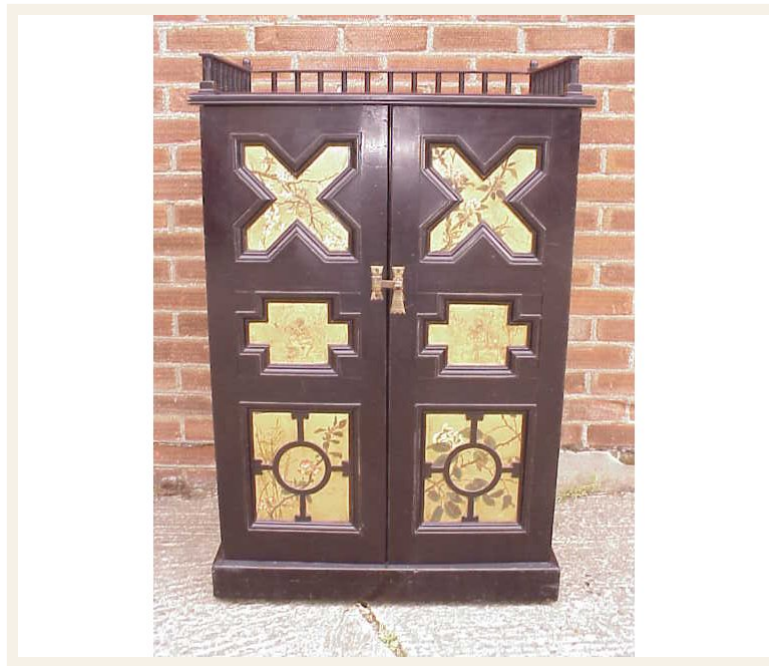




## Dr. Christopher Dresser Attributed, ebonised music cabinet, with six painted panels Attributed, to Moyr Smith

### About this piece

Dr Christopher Dresser (attributed). An ebonised music cabinet, with six painted panels attributed to Moyr Smith, the upper pair in the shape of crosses with painted Japanese floral details, the central pair depicting a violinist and a harpist sitting on a Greek stylised chair, the lower pair square shaped with applied circular cross and Japanese flower, the doors with incised geometric latch style handles enclosing ten drop-front drawers, compartments to the base.
