About this piece

Side table in **walnut**, attributed to E. W. Godwin, aligned to the *Aesthetic Movement* (1860–1890), **c.1875**, British. The table has an octagonal top with rounded moulded edge, set above shaped aprons and a light open underframe.

The whole stands on four slender ring-turned legs, slightly splayed at the feet and joined by a double row of fine turned stretchers. The form is spare and architectural, with most of the design carried by the octagonal top, curved apron line and repeated horizontal rails below.
