About this piece

Pair of folding chairs in **ebonised wood**, in the style of E. W. Godwin and aligned to the *Aesthetic Movement* (1860–1890), **1880**, British.

A pair of Aesthetic Movement ebonised folding chairs with bobbin details to the backrests and cane seats. Each chair has a low folding frame, curved side supports and a simple open back structure, giving the pair a light occasional-use profile.
