About this piece

Dining chair in ebonised bentwood by Gustav Siegel for J and J Kohn from the *Art Nouveau* movement (1890–1910), c.1905. The design features a slightly bowed back with a vertical splat arrangement above a circular seat and arched legs, combining structural lightness with formal balance. Two retain newly re-caned seats to original specification.

Gustav Siegel, a key designer for the Viennese firm J and J Kohn, refined the bentwood technique into elegant and ergonomically advanced forms suited to cafés and domestic interiors of the early twentieth century. This model exemplifies the firm's contribution to the *Art Nouveau* aesthetic through modern industrial craftsmanship and sculptural design economy.
