About this piece

This **ceiling light** in **vaseline glass** sits within the late *Arts & Crafts* (1880–1910) tradition, **c.1900**, English. The broad domed shade carries soft internal floral motifs that read through the pale yellow-green glass. A plain brass rim finishes the edge, with a simple brass gallery and suspension loop above, giving a wide spread of light suited to hall or dining settings.

Construction is straightforward and workshop-led: a single domed shade with a clean, polished top aperture, secured by a fitted brass rim and hung from a turned gallery. The effect relies on the glass itself rather than applied ornament, the brass providing a durable mount. Within Arts and Crafts lighting, vaseline glass was valued for its gentle diffusion and colour, pairing honest materials and simple metalwork to achieve atmosphere through proportion and glow.
