About this piece

By **Liberty & Co** (attributed), an **Anglo-Japanese walnut armchair** aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (1880–1910), **c.1900**. The tall, gently raked back and square seat sit within a light walnut frame. **Wavy arm supports** continue **through to the side stretchers**, a hallmark of Anglo-Japanese line and construction, with plain square legs and simple rails that keep the emphasis on proportion. Upholstered back and seat in patterned fabric present cleanly.
