About this piece

This **Arts and Crafts pewter rocket vase by Archibald Knox for Liberty & Co.**, model 0226, was produced around 1910 and represents one of the most distinctive designs from the firm's celebrated *Tudric* range. The elongated bombe body, embossed with stylised leaf and scroll motifs, rises from three sweeping supports that taper to angular feet.

The composition encapsulates Knox's synthesis of *Celtic Art Nouveau* and Arts and Crafts geometry, fluid organic forms disciplined by structure. His designs for Liberty's *English Pewter* and *Tudric* lines transformed pewter into a modern material of elegance and

restraint, elevating functional domestic objects into sculptural statements.

Stamped “*English Pewter, No. 0226*” (See last two images), the vase stands as a hallmark of early twentieth-century design reform, merging artistry and manufacture in perfect harmony.
