### About this piece

An Arts and Crafts single wardrobe attributed to M H Ballie Scott with strong inlaid details and soft green glass to the door. This was purchased on the Isle Of Man. The quality and build of this is a step above, all the oak used to make this is an inch thick, the top is thicker. The oak has been hand chosen for the wonderful grain and figuring one can see in the images. The door opens to reveal an upper shelf and a rail with full space hanging below. Height 6', Width at cornice 43 1/2", Depth of cornice 22 3/4". Circa 1900.
