### About this piece

#### Attributed to M. H. Baillie Scott

A hand forged iron grate with integrated andirons. Scroll details to the top and to the front.

The grate measures **12"** across at the very back, **10"** along each side, and **18"** at the front where the grate starts. The fire dogs are **37"** apart at the furthest toes and protrude **11"** from the front of the grate to the front toe of the dogs.

The overall depth from the front toe to the very back is **21"**.
