### About this piece

#### Morris & Co.

Designed by **Edward Burne Jones** in 1861-1862. A rare Arts and Crafts Pre-Raphaelite hand-painted tile depicting Geoffrey Chaucer's poem, 'Legend of Good Wimmen'.

The tile has at some point been damaged and it is missing a corner, which we have shown in one of the images. It seems reasonable to suggest that this is why it had a circular frame specially made for it.

The Fiberite packing we found inside the frame dates back to the *1920s* or *1930s*, so it is likely this is when the frame was made.
