#### R. Whytock & Co., Of Edinburgh

A rare set of four high Aesthetic Movement walnut ebonized and parcel gilt side chairs with carved griffins' head finials. An unusual pair of artistic chairs with extensive incised gilded line and floral decoration throughout, and also to the stretchers. Stamped **R. Whytock & Co., Edinburgh** under the seat on all four chairs (one shown in the last images) as well as stamped production number 4498 on one, and production number 5142 on three.
