About this piece

By **Thorten and Downer**, attributed, a **pair of fire dogs** in **steel**, aligned to the *Arts and Crafts* movement (**1880–1910**), **c.1900**, in the Cotswold School idiom. Each has a tall upright with rolled scroll finial above a twisted stem and a low billet arm for the logs. Surfaces show hand working, with decorative chasing to select areas and a practical rectangular foot that sits cleanly on the hearth.

Form and detailing are consistent with Cotswold School metalwork of the period. The scroll tops give a restrained flourish, while the straightforward construction, visible forging and balanced proportions keep the focus on function.
