**William Birch.** A pair of oak dining chairs by the High Wycombe maker **William Birch**, known for his contribution to the **Arts and Crafts Movement** and for collaborating with leading designers of the period. Each chair features a solid oak frame with subtly curved back supports and a shaped top rail with a central pierced handle motif. The construction expresses Birch's preference for simple honesty of design and exposed joinery. Unrestored condition.
